

Jamaica Pig Farmers' Association (JPFA) 20th Anniversary Scholarship (2022)

BACKGROUND

The Jamaica Pig Farmer's Association (JPFA) is commemorating its 20th year anniversary. As part of the activities related to this commemoration, the Association's Executive has decided to offer a Jamaican National, a Scholarship to pursue the undergraduate programme in animal science at the College of Agriculture, Science and Education (CASE). This JPFA Scholarship is a ONE-OFF AWARD, commencing in the first Semester of the 2022-2023 academic year, and will cover only the original duration for which the student has matriculated. This JPFA Scholarship does not apply to overseas study.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this Scholarship, candidates should meet the following criteria:

- 1) Must be Jamaican National by birth.
- 2) Must demonstrate financial need for scholarship assistance.
- 3) Should be involved in community service/extracurricular activities.
- 4) Must submit:
 - i. A written application in published format.

ii. Two (2) letters regarding character and motivation; one from a recent academic source and one from their community.

iii. Copy of Birth Certificate/Passport certified by a Justice of the Peace.

6) Must sit for an interview by a selection panel. Misleading the selection panel will result in disqualification.

The successful candidate must present certified copies of transcripts to JPFA at the end of each academic year.

Daughters/Sons of registered pig farmers are encouraged to apply.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

Applicant should submit the completed and signed application form and copies of the required document in a sealed envelope to the JPFA Secretariat by no later than October 14, 2022. The Application Form is available from the JPFA Secretariat and can be downloaded from the JPFA website <u>www.jamaicapigfarmers.net</u> or at the office of the Director, International Relations and Marketing, CASE.
